RULES

- Race held in accordance with WA, ASA and CGA rules
- The race number is to be worn over the permanent licence number on the front of the upper clothing and be placed so that the ASA province and year remain visible
- Both provincial licences MUST be worn in the upper part of the vest/crop top (front and back)
- Please bring proof of payment when collecting your race number
- Post hydration provided
- Tog bag facilities will be provided - use of them are at the participant's own risk (race officials/organisers are not liable for loss of personal belongings)
- All participants must wear 2026 ASA Licence numbers, and relevant age category tags on the upper part of the vest/crop top (front and back) to qualify for prizes
- All relevant age categories must be clearly visible
- No refunds
- No pacing permitted
- Provincial Athletics Approved Club Kit must be worn
- Participants must obey marshals, traffic officials and race officials
- 10km participants must be from 14 years of age. Junior athletes must be 19 years of age or younger on 31 December in the year of the competition, must wear a 'J' on the upper front and back of the vest/crop top to be eligible for prizes and must provide proof of age on race day
- Proof of ID is required for prize giving
- There will be no prize money for the 5km event as this is a Fun Run
- Unregistered athletes running with temporary licences must run in neutral colours and adhere to WA and ASA advertising rules. Holders of temporary licences will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim age category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA rules
- By entering this event you consent to images captured during the race being used in future marketing materials
- No substitutions are allowed
- Participants under 18 years may only participate with the consent of a parent or legal guardian, who accepts the event indemnity on the minor's behalf
- By registering a Minor, the parent or legal guardian confirms that they have the legal authority to provide such consent and indemnifies Hollywoodbets, the organisers, sponsors and associated parties against any claims arising from the minor's participation
- Participants under 14 years in the 5km event must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or responsible adult (18 years or older) for the duration of the race
- Proof of age and parental/legal guardian consent may be requested at any time
- Hollywoodbets reserves the right to refuse or remove any Minor participant where the required consent and indemnity have not been provided

- Athletes indemnify and will not hold responsible the national, provincial, and regional athletics bodies, sponsors, and the race organizer against all claims or actions of whatever nature arising from participation in the event
- Athletes participate entirely at their own risk. By entering any CGA sanctioned event, athletes confirm they are medically fit to participate and accept full responsibility for their health. Participants must provide the name and contact number of their next of kin when entering a race
- Licensed athletes must wear their permanent license numbers on the front and back of their registered club vest or t-shirt. The issued race number must be worn on the front without obscuring sponsor name/s or logo/s
- Athletes not affiliated with a club must purchase a temporary license when entering online or at the registration venue before the start of the race and these must be worn at the back of the upper garment and the issued race number on the front of the upper garment
- Foreign athletes must purchase a temporary license when participating at any CGA sanctioned event
- In any events/races when an athlete cannot be present at the prize giving ceremony, by prior arrangement, a representative of the prize-winning athlete may collect the award on the athlete's behalf during the award ceremony. Failing the above, the athlete will forfeit his/her prize money
- Prize winners must present a valid identity document to the appointed referees before prize-giving or at any other time required
- Walkers competing for walkers' prizes must wear walker tags on the front and back of their running tops and must comply with the ASA Domestic Rules and Regulations
- The use of earphones, headsets, or similar devices during the race is strictly prohibited
- Participants must request permission from the race organiser prior to the race for the use of wheel carts, prams, or wheelchairs
- No animals or pets are permitted to participate in any CGA sanctioned events
- Failure to comply with these rules, or any other rules issued by the race organiser, may result in immediate disqualification, forfeiture of prize money, nullification of results, or a combination thereof. Further remedial action may be taken in line with the CGA/ASA Constitution. The decision of the race referee is final
